NOTES:

1. Our Summer League started April 27, 2008 and is currently scheduled to end August 17. The League will not shoot May 11, the weekend of the ATA Zone Shoot, and June 29, the weekend of the NSSA Junior Shoot. Depending on the Fall schedule which is yet to be determined, the shoot scheduled for August 17 may be rescheduled as the first week of the Fall League. A shoot may be added in conjunction with the proposed 'Round Robin Shoot' on July 12 as plans for that develop further.
2. The standard match consists of five relays of five shots for a total of 25 shots fired offhand at approximately 100 yards.
3. We have classes in regular pistol, open pistol and cowboy lever action rifle. Ammunition is restricted to the traditional pistol cartridges such as .22 rimfire, .22 Hornet, 25-20, 32-20, 38s including the .357 magnum, 38-40, the .44s including the Remington Magnum and the .45s.
4. We are using the following definition of a cowboy lever action rifle for the rifle event: Any lever action rifle with a tubular magazine designed for use with a rimmed pistol cartridge loaded with a flat nosed bullet, i.e. 22 long rifle, 22 magnum, 25-20, 32-20, 32 H&R, 38s, 357 magnum, 38-40, 44s and 45s. The use of any other type of ammunition may be prohibited by local regulations. Likewise loads that damage targets may be disapproved by the appointed range officers for the Steel Plate Range.
5. Ten scores are required to complete a league. Please remember that you can shoot two rounds on any given shoot date. The first round shot counts for score that day, the second can be applied forward or back to cover days missed.
