GREEN PHASE

OPERATING RESTRICTIONS

Effective Friday, June 5th, 2020 the Club will continue operation of outdoor ranges and grounds and will **reopen the KITCHEN & BAR**, consistent with the Governor's Orders & Guidelines that move southwestern PA. counties into the **GREEN PHASE of REOPENING**. Use of outdoor ranges, grounds and facilities is subject to appropriate social restrictions to continue controlling the spread of the COVID-19 virus, to protect staff and members, and to comply with CDC and PA. DOH requirements.

General restrictions apply to all ranges, grounds, and facilities. Range specific restrictions apply to specific ranges.

In general, these restrictions apply to OFF HOURS range use. Scheduled events require Officer approval, as other restrictions may be appropriate and to ensure that the following restrictions are met.

GREEN PHASE restrictions may be changing, Club restrictions may change accordingly. PLEASE check the website and the sign-in desk for updates prior to using any range.

MANDATORY GENERAL RESTRICTIONS – ALL RANGES:

1. Range use is restricted to members and their guests. Exceptions apply to some scheduled events. Members are to be given preference at such events.
2. SIGN-IN requirements still apply when applicable. Sign-In disinfecting instructions are posted.
3. CDC social distancing requirements are MANDATORY everywhere on Club grounds or in Club Facilities.
4. The wearing of masks is not required but is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.
5. Range specific restrictions also apply.

PISTOL RANGE RESTRICTIONS:

1. Pistol Range #1 is restricted to one shooter at each of the covered firing line target boards (i.e., 7.5 yard target, 15 yard target, 25 yard target, and 50 yard target).
2. Pistol Range #1 100 yard targets are restricted to one shooter at the 100 yard covered firing line and one shooter at the far right bench.
3. Pistol Range #2 & #3 are restricted to one shooter at each of the two firing line target boards.
4. Pistol benches, chairs, and downrange activation switches & sign are to be sanitized after use. Disinfecting spray and towels are provided.

RIFLE RANGE RESTRICTIONS:

1. Shooting benches #2, #4, #6, #8, & #10 are CLOSED, with shooting benches #1, #3, #5, #7, & #9 are available for use.
2. Rifle benches, chairs, and downrange activation switches are to be sanitized after use. Disinfecting spray and towels are provided.

SUPERVISED CMP RANGE RESTRICTIONS:

1. Firing points #2, #4, #6, #8, & #10 are CLOSED. Firing points #1, #3, #5, #7, #9 & #11 are available for use (Supervised Only).

MUZZLELOADER RANGE RESTRICTIONS:

1. No range specific restrictions apply.

TRAP & FIVE STAND RESTRICTIONS:

1. Shooting positions are at least 6 feet apart. Consequently, no range specific restrictions apply.
2. The Clubhouse may be used on a limited basis for scheduling shooters. Limitations and disinfecting requirements will be posted.

SKEET RESTRICTIONS:

1. No range specific restrictions apply.
2. The remote control units and the Skeet Building areas touched are to be sanitized after use. Disinfecting spray and towels are provided.

PISTOL PLATE RANGE RESTRICTIONS:

1. Shooting positions are to be adjusted to ensure social distancing requirements.

ARCHERY RESTRICTIONS:

1. No range specific restrictions apply to the outdoor ranges.
2. For the INDOOR ARCHERY RANGE, shooting positions #1, #3, #4, #6, #7, #9, #10, & #12 are CLOSED. Shooting positions #2, #5, #8, & #11 are available for use.
3. Frequently touched surfaces in the Archery Building are to be routinely sanitized. Disinfecting spray and towels are available.

ACTION PISTOL / RIFLE RESTRICTIONS:

1. Action Pistol Bays #1 & #6 are restricted to a maximum of 6 shooters each. Action Pistol Bays #2, #3, & #4 are restricted to 4 shooters each.
2. For POLICE TRAINING & QUALIFICATION, their Department specific social restrictions policies & procedures apply.

KITCHEN & BAR REOPENING:

Reopening of the KITCHEN & BAR is subject to additional specific requirements and guidelines from the Governor and the PA. Liquor Control Board (PLCB). These include social distancing, wearing of masks, building reduced capacity restrictions and more.

We plan on reopening on our previous schedule of Sunday Afternoon and Monday, Wednesday, & Friday Evenings.

These restrictions are being evaluated and will be communicated and posted when available.
