CONTINUOUS CLUB IMPROVEMENTS....

- The Clubhouse has been experiencing a drainage issue with rain water, resulting in water entering the Clubhouse main hall on several occasions. The drainage piping has been inspected using cameras. A significant blockage has been found that cannot be removed by snaking. Also, 4 inch drains from both sides of the building come together into a 4 inch drain pipe which is too small to handle the rain from the roof area. We will be excavating in the parking lot in front of the clubhouse to remove the blockage and install 6 inch piping.
- **SBA CELL TOWER:** We're starting to see interest by SBA to move forward with the Permanent Cell tower. More info to follow.
- **The REGISTERED SKEET SHOOT held on July 15th was a great success fielding 31 shooters in the 12 and 28 gauge event. GREAT JOB!**

- **All members are reminded that SIGN IN at the Clubhouse Sign In Desk is required, and that ALL INFORMATION ON THE SIGN IN SHEET MUST BE COMPLETED. - **We have experienced several members holstering firearms and drawing from holsters at the PISTOL RANGES during Off Hours use. Members are reminded that "HOLSTERING / UNHOLSTERING OF FIREARMS ARE NOT PERMITTED" at the Pistol Ranges.**
- **CLUB ROAD SPEED LIMIT is 15 mph. Odey the SPEED LIMIT. Members and their pets walk the road, archers cross the road, volunteers mow grass along the road. Safety is our #1 concern!**
